### Conclusions and recommendations:

#### At national level :

- A. We need more tools in order to strengthen support and implementation of forest fire prevention:
- Data collection of the financing of prevention, suppression and restoration
  - Establishment of an interdisciplinary national committee for data collection and validation
  - Standardisation and harmonisation of the data
  - Estimation of economic impact of forest fires
  - Balance in policies at local level between Prevention and Suppression.
  - Forest education
