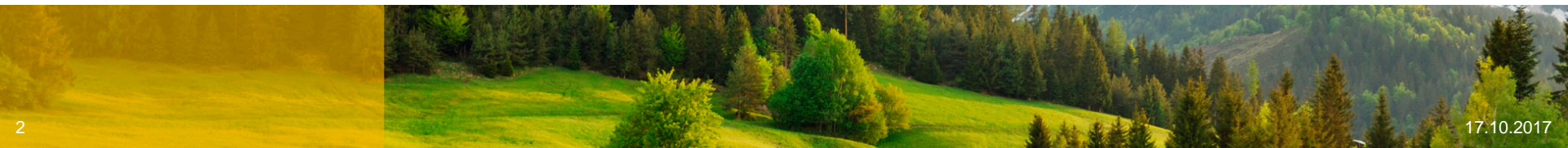

- ❖ Key or headline indicators (based on EC, 2015 and OLI, 2016)



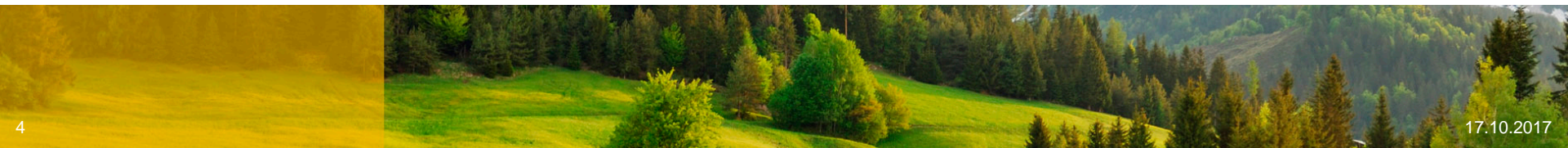


Further procedure

Subsets:

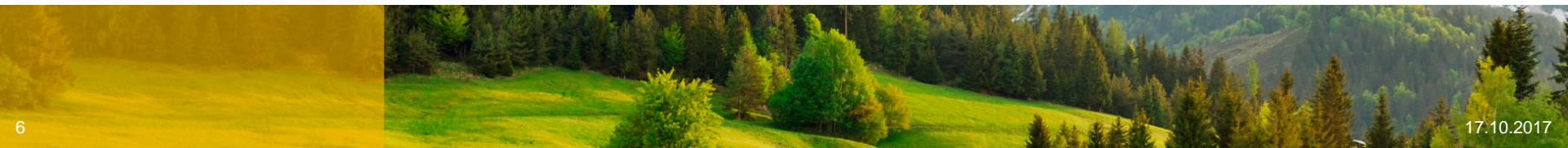
- How many indicators per subset? 10?

Key Indicators:

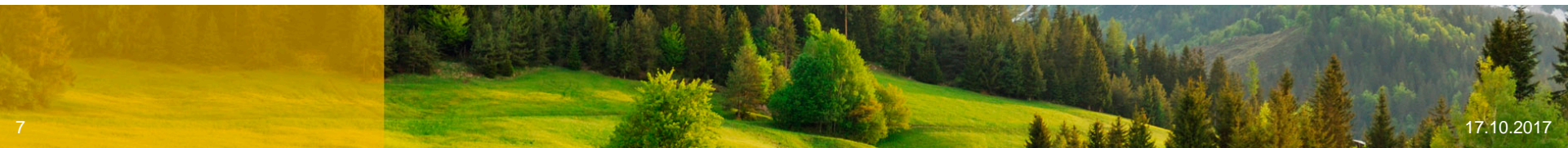
- Maximum number of key indicators?
